PRE-ELEC[®] TPU 16619 is a conductive thermoplastic elastomer compound based on a polyether thermoplastic polyurethane (TPU). Conductivity is achieved by using special conductive carbon black. In addition to a low electrical resistivity, it has retained the excellent mechanical properties of the base elastomer. The grade is suitable for extrusion and injection moulding applications.

Notes

Drying of the product is recommended for 3 hours at 80-90°C prior to use.

Processing conditions as with filled Polyether-TPU. The moisture content after drying should be less than 200 ppm in order to avoid loss of properties. The shelf life for this product is 1 year from the date of delivery with the same conditions as written below. These parameters are for guidance only. The process parameters should always be optimized for the used equipment. The instructions of the equipment manufacturer should be followed. Caution should be taken when handling molten material as it is extremely hot and may cause severe burns.

Storage

Product-specific details are mentioned in the notes above. The general minimum shelf life for Premix's product is 3 years with the following conditions: 1) original package is unopened, 2) the storage area and conditions provide protection from direct sunlight and significant changes in storage temperature, 3) the product is pre-dried accordingly before use.

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
